4. To elect representatives to represent BME communities to sit on various decision-making bodies in the borough, and to champion issues affecting BME communities.

Summary of last meeting of the Task Group

At the last meeting of the Task Group we discussed recruitment, amongst other things, and we tried to look at what avenues were best to yield the best potential. It was agreed that Paul do some of this on his outreach work with the Mary Seacole Trust and that he gets together with the Secretary of the Task Group. The issues of recruitment and membership will be explored more thoroughly at future meetings.

Tony Wright was also appointed as the Deputy for Khan Moghal as BME representative on Trafford Partnership, which everyone agreed was very good news for Voice of BME – Trafford.

Tony Wright and Adele Coyne also fed back on the Community Cohesion Meeting that was held on 10th October 2006. This is part of a 6-month programme with regular meetings to discuss Health, Education and Crime Prevention and Youth Harm. Councillor Whit Stennett MBE was also at this meeting. A report will be published for the Commission on Integration and Cohesion for Ruth Kelly, and a sraft was promised for the participants.
